The mother is the main figure in human destiny. Because he creates a new person from his body, brings him into the world of light, educates him, teaches him to speak, walk, live, struggle. To protect her child, she herself is a shield against those calamities, but she always wishes her offspring peace and well-being. In general, the wealth of words is less than the praise of this great man madhu. This is the reason why Alisher Navoi, as in other lyrical and

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epic works, has a special place in the Nazm-ul Javohir for the praise of mothers. The notion that whatever you do to your parents will come back to you from your child is also expressed in one of the rubai of Nazm-ul Jawahir:

Make it a habit to give birth to a child,

May he prosper in his profession,

Let everyone obey the gift,

Let this work infect your son.

Attention is also paid to the issues of how to deal with the future spouse in marriage, which determines the programmatic significance of "Nazm-ul Javohir" in our daily lives:

Topting chu woman good etkurgil,

Teach good manners,

No matter how polite you are,

Be kind to Hailing.

These verses are reminiscent of the following hadiths of the Prophet (peace and blessings of Allaah be upon him) about the family: [6. 440].

Or what to look for when finding a mate in life is also described in impressive artistic means:

Be a master of your craft,

Pay close attention to the situation,

Mukrim, on the other hand, is a prophet.

According to Judy, visit her mother.

This testifies to the fact that religious and secular issues are equally important and inspiring in the creative work of the great poet and thinker. Indeed, the unique role and place of women in both family life and public life has been rightly justified.
